# OAESA Distinguished Principal Award

Elementary and middle school administrators are extremely proud of the accomplishments and contributions school principals have made toward the welfare and advancement of education in the state of Ohio.

The Ohio Association of Elementary School Administrators (OAESA) and the Foundation to Advance Childhood Education (FACE) annually recognize two members as Ohio Distinguished Principals. These principals represent Ohio in the National Association of Elementary School Principals (NAESP) National Distinguished Principal program in Washington, D.C. NAESP honors one elementary principal and one middle school principal from each state.

A cash prize will be made to each recipient of the OAESA Distinguished Principal Award. The monetary award may be used entirely at the principal's discretion.

## Criteria

Nominees will be judged on the following:

- Leadership and Management
- Parent / Community Relations
- High Standards for Students
- Climate / School Atmosphere
- Personal / Professional Growth

## Nominations

Any school administrator, teacher, school employee, principals' association, parent group, or citizens' group that feels a particular elementary or middle school principal exemplifies quality leadership in education may nominate a principal for consideration for this award. (Self nominations are permitted.)

Nominations must be made on the attached form and postmarked or electronically submitted by November 1, 2010.

All nominees will be mailed an application for the 2011 OAESA Distinguished Principal Award.



## Selection Procedure

The Distinguished Principal Committee, with assistance from the OAESA staff, will review all the applications to determine that the basic criteria have been met. Members of the committee score the applications in the blind and will select three to five nominees to be interviewed. An on-site visit to the finalists' schools will be conducted by a separate team of administrators.

## Awards

OAESA Distinguished Principal Award recipients will be announced in early May and will be recognized during the 2011 OAESA Professional Conference. Details for the Awards Luncheon will be available soon. In addition, those selected will represent Ohio in October of 2011 at the National Distinguished Principal Program in Washington, D.C.

## Special Requirements

Nominees must be a *Professional* member of OAESA for the current and previous year, and *Active* member of NAESP.

The nominee must be a practicing elementary or middle-level principal having completed five full years of service. (Years of service do not have to be consecutive or in the same district and prior years served as an assistant principal may apply.)

Once a principal receives the Distinguished Principal Award, he or she may not reapply.
