During the past year, the Consulting Division completed the following fire officer selection processes: Pleasant Township Fire Chief, Greenfield Township Fire Chief, and Prairie Township Assistant Fire Chief. Projects completed over the past year included: Butler County Shared Services Study, Central Ohio Fire District Fire Station Location and Facilities Plan, Tipp City EMS Operational Review, city of Oregon Fire Station Location Analysis, Bainbridge Township Fire Department Organizational Evaluation, and the Washington Township Fire Department Strategic Planning update.
