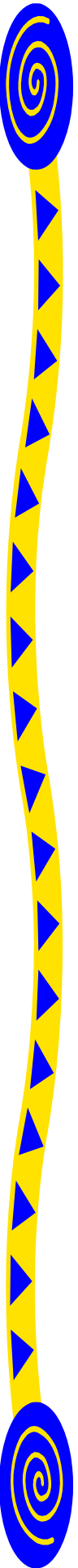
REGISTRATION INFORMATION
