

# Photo Challenge Groups

Photo Challenge Groups will change you as a photographer. But you must make a commitment to stick with them. Your group also needs to be committed to setting short term project goals and then meeting to share and discuss your work.

On this go-around of group assignments, I've purposely overloaded the groups with five or six participants, since naturally some folks won't make the necessary commitment. Don't let that be you! And don't let that discourage you.

Since it's necessary to meet once each month, I've tried to group folks geographically as best as possible.

## What to Do Next...

1. Familiarize yourself with the Photo Challenge Groups (PCG) section on the Westbridge website. There are useful tips on how PCGs should operate, on critiquing and more.
2. The leader should contact all the other members in the group by phone or email, by **Sunday, November 7th**. You can find contact information via the directory search on the website.
3. Survey the members in your group and establish the time and place to meet that works best for the majority. Then set your first meeting so folks can meet and greet one another. You might have folks bring a handful of sample images to share.
4. Hold your first face-to-face meeting by **Sunday, November 21st**.
5. The topic for your first group 'photo challenge' will be posted on the Westbridge website within the next several days - along with other instructions.
